



Graduate Recognition: Jonathan Hagy: We celebrate Jonathan's graduation this Saturday, May 18 from the University of Virginia. Jonathan is the son of Tamrya and Stewart Spradlin. Jonathan will graduate from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy with a Bachelor of Arts in Public Policy and Leadership, minoring in Spanish, and will likely graduate with honors. Prior to UVA, Jonathan attended the University of Virginia's College at Wise for one year where he served as the Counsel for the Defense for the UVA Wise Honor Court and made the Dean's List in both semesters. During his time at UVA, Jonathan completed a variety of research, represented the

University at national conferences and abroad, and served his region and the local Charlottesville community.

In his first year on Grounds, Jonathan delivered remarks to the University's President and Board of Visitors regarding the Year in Wise transfer program, of which he is a proud alum. In the summer of 2022, he studied the Politics of the European Union abroad at University College, Oxford University, England. In 2023, he was selected as one of two Delegates from UVA to attend the 63rd Naval Academy Foreign Affairs Conference at the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis, Maryland, and as one of four Delegates for the 65th Academy Assembly at the United States Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado. In UVA's first time attending the Naval Academy Foreign Affairs Conference, Jonathan was recognized as Outstanding Delegate from his conference discussion group regarding international institutions. a Research Assistant position in the Summer of 2023 with the Batten School's National Security Policy Center at UVA. He completed foundational research and interviews for the Center's newest project centering on American Military and Democracy. He continued his research throughout the 2023-2024 school year and will also work with the Center this upcoming summer.

Outside of class, Jonathan was an active member of Formative Change Group Consulting and Chi Alpha Christian Fellowship, and he was a Regular Member of the Jefferson Literary and Debate Society. Through Formative Change Group, Jonathan completed two year-long service projects; one partnering with a local food pantry in Charlottesville and the other partnering with a local church in Charlottesville. In his final semester, Jonathan was on the planning committee for the first ever "Batten Leadership Conference", and he facilitated "Dialogue Dinners" meant to bring students together within his school to discuss sensitive current political and global topics.

After graduation, Jonathan will intern in the Washington, DC Office of House of Representatives member, Kat Cammack (FL-3rd District) this summer. He will assist the office in various duties, including running their Flag Program, performing constituent services, and potentially taking notes in committee meetings. In the Fall, he will begin law school at the University of Richmond School of Law, entering as a 1L in Richmond's JD class of 2027.
