Tireless efforts by Parke, our media team, and the expert assistance of Zach Harless enabled us to provide an excellent live-streaming service on Sunday. Thank you to all those who were involved in preparing for and conducting this service. Also, I am excited to report that we have a new multimedia camera system on the way to us. This new system will further enhance our live-streaming worship and other experiences. This system has been completely paid for by an anonymous and generous donation. Glory to God!

We are continuing to review and refine our new mode of live-streaming worship. I hope that you will tune-in either from our church website

(www.abingdonbaptist.org) or from our Facebook page (@[abingdonbaptistchurch](https://www.facebook.com/abingdonbaptistchurch)) next Sunday as we "gather" for worship from around our region and across the country. We had participants this past Sunday from North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and even out in Texas. If you miss the live-streaming broadcast on Sunday morning, the service video will be available for playback at your convenience either on our website or Facebook page. We will also continue to post audio-only recordings of just the sermon on the church website.

Please let us know that you are watching by commenting or pressing the Facebook "like" or "love" buttons, by sending us an e-mail, or by giving us a call. We want to make the live-streaming service as much like our "normal" worship service as we can. However, some elements must be revised, streamlined, or left out as appropriate. We want you to experience true worship even as we gather in this new electronic environment.

Sunday School – This past Sunday the "Odds and Ends" class, at the initiative of Steve Lowe, conducted an on-line class using ZOOM. I understand that they had an excellent experience of both being "together" and learning. If you would like to tune in to their class next Sunday, please get in touch with Steve or call the church office and let Trina know. We hope to develop other online Sunday school experiences for other groups in the near future.

Wednesday Night Bible Study – This Wednesday, March 25, I will post a video of our weekly Bible study on our website and Facebook page. You may view the teaching video at 6:00pm on Wednesday, our normal study time, or you may view it at a time convenient to you. It will be available to you beginning on Wednesday afternoon. This week we will consider, "A Blind Beggar Receives His Sight" from Luke 18:35-43.

We want to provide you with technical support so that you can get the latest information as well as worship and study with us electronically. Trina will take your information and be in touch with our technical team. One of them will give you a call to help.

Giving – Of course, our bills continue to come in even though we are not all present to collect our tithes and offerings as usual. You have several options to continue to give through the Realm App, through our website, by U.S. mail, or by dropping off your offering in person at the church Monday to Thursday 9am-5pm or Friday 9am-noon. In the REALM...

I'm launching a new column for the next several weeks. The purpose is to introduce our congregation to REALM. Our mission is to help each of us CONNECT and build COMMUNITY using our new digital COMMUNICATION tool – REALM. What a timely tool we have at our disposal in these days of social distancing. The realm we all are familiar with is the Kingdom of God. Jesus began his ministry by proclaiming the Kingdom of God is at hand. The Israelites, through the plagues in Exodus, learned that the Kingdom of God was moving on, into the wilderness. We in our community of faith are being called to move forward in new ways to keep our faith growing and maintain our connections with each other. Facebook Live, Zoom, hangouts, WhatsApp, texting, online giving, telecommuting, shelter down...; are terms exploding in usage each day. What are we going to do to keep ABC a vibrant dynamic community of faith, able to respond to the many and growing needs of our neighbors?

To access REALM you must have an individual email address. Each person will use that as their ID to securely login to REALM with a password you create. Everyone in our congregation with an individual email has been invited to join REALM. Check your junk mail folder if you can't find the email. Or call the office – we will send you another invitation. Can't find the invite – call us. Follow the instructions in the email to set your password. You now have the ability to log into REALM.

There are two ways to do REALM. 1) At your computer you will go to www.onrealm.org, login with your email and password. Check out your profile. Update information as needed. Explore the groups you already belong to. 2) On your smartphone or tablet, Download the "Connect – Our Church Community" app and install it. When you open the app you will be prompted for your email and password. Find members of our church or the groups you are a part of. I am more than happy to assist you in getting connected to REALM. Call me and we can arrange a time convenient to us both. Even if we can't touch – that does not mean we can't be in touch and be connected. "...All in this together."
