ZOOM in to Sunday School – We now have four options for you to **join an online adult Sunday school class. Each class will begin at 10:15am this Sunday, April 5.**

You will need a desktop, laptop, i-pad, tablet, or surface computer with an Internet connection, camera, and microphone. The camera and microphone are usually built-in to laptops, i-pads, tablets, and surface computers. You can also use your smartphone by downloading the ZOOM application to your phone. It is available for free from your App Store and is available for either iPhone or Android devices. Also, personal ZOOM accounts for use on your computer can be set up for free right now. However, to join a class you don't even need to set up a ZOOM account. Simply follow these steps:

1. Open your Internet browser (e.g., Edge, FireFox, Google Chrome) and enter this address:

2. Enter the Meeting ID and Password, if required, for the class that you would like to join.

Technical Help – If you are having trouble accessing ZOOM, Realm, our church website, or viewing our live-streaming service on Facebook, please contact Trina in the church office. We want to provide you with technical support so that you can get the latest information as well as worship and study with us electronically. Trina will take your information and be in touch with our technical team and one of them will call you to help.

Wednesday Night Bible Study – Each Wednesday for the foreseeable future, I will post a video of our weekly Bible study on our church website and Facebook page. You may view the teaching video at 6pm on Wednesday, our normal study time, or you may view it at a time convenient to you. It will be available on Wednesday afternoon. This week as we approach Palm Sunday we will study "**The Triumphal Entry**" from **Luke 19:28-40**.

Remember, you have are two options to do REALM.

- 1) At your computer you will go to www.onrealm.org, login with your email and password.
- 2) On your smartphone or tablet, Download the "Connect Our Church Community" app and install it. When you open the app you will be prompted for your email and password. Find members of our church or the groups you are a part of.

Now that you are connected. Here are a couple tasks you may want to try.

Check out your profile and update information in your profile. More profile information is available through the computer. The **Connect** app has basic contact information. Please update your birthdate. Your birth year is only visible to staff. There are many reporting functions in REALM that summarize data by age ranges. It really helps us get a clear picture of our congregation on many levels.

Explore the groups you already belong to. See and communicate with the other member of your groups. Post a picture you want to share. Start some shat messages.

You may want to join a new group. We added four virtual groups this week for ZOOM Sunday School classes. Go to "find a group" and you can ask the group leader to join. Our goal is to help each of us **CONNECT** and build **COMMUNITY** using our new digital **COMMUNICATION** tool – REALM.

I am more than happy to assist you in getting connected to REALM. Call me and we can arrange a time convenient to us both. Even if we can't touch – that does not mean we can't be in touch and be connected. "...All in this together."
