THE GOSPEL OF MARK

Making a Mark – This Wednesday, January 13 we will launch an in-depth study of the Gospel of Mark on Wednesday nights. We will begin at Mark 1:1 and work our way through all sixteen chapters of this gospel section-by-section. Our study this week will focus on just the first verse as we introduce the background and setting. The

planned, detailed study of God's word should leave a positive mark on our lives. I pray that each of us will be marked for good as we study this gospel together over the coming months. If you would like a study guide as an aid to this in-depth study, I plan to use Warren Wiersbe's *Be Diligent* (ISBN: 978143476631). BH Carroll Online Courses – In these dreary days of a pandemic winter, you may be interested in using your time wisely. As a supporting church of B.H. Carroll Theological Institute, we have access to several online

courses at a discounted rate of only \$60 per student. Here are the three online courses currently available to us. If you are interested in taking any of these courses, please contact me to sign up.

Small Groups Ministry led by Dr. Joshua Rose – An 8-week course providing an introductory study of the development, training, implementation, and evaluation of small group ministry. Students will be equipped to lead churches in the use of small groups for spiritual formation and evangelism. **Tuesdays 7:30pm-9:00pm EST from January 12 to March 2, 2021**

Leadership in Ministry led by Dr. Gene Wilkes, BH Carroll President – An 8-week study of the principles and practices of leadership for Christian ministry. It includes reflections on the role and ministry of leaders within church, community, and denomination. **Wednesdays 12:30pm-2:00pm EST from January 13 to March 3, 2021**

Prison Epistles-Colossians led by Dr. Randall Worley – In this 8-week course, we will consider the historical context for the writing of the letter to the Colossians, addressing differing views regarding authorship and date, as well as possible reconstructions of the specific heresies being addressed in the letter. We will also work our way through the letter and study its content in detail, with a view not only to understanding its contribution to the life of the church in terms of theology, but of praxis as well. **Wednesdays 7:30pm-9:00pm EST from January 13 to March 3, 2021**
