

From Our Pastor. . .



Rev. Parke L. Deans Announces Retirement – As you most likely have heard by now, Parke has officially announced his plans to retire as our Minister of Music & Worship effective Easter Sunday, April 4, 2021. We have been blessed by his kingdom service with us over the past fifteen years and his willingness to continue that work with us over the next two months as he transitions to retirement. We wish Parke and Margaret all the best in their well-deserved retirement.

Of course, Parke's retirement will leave many ministry activities in need of care as we search for another minister(s). Your Council of Deacons has reviewed and approved a plan that will allow for both the continuation of Parke's ministry activities after his

departure and the search for the minister(s) who will serve with us into the future. A summary of this two-pronged transition plan is summarized below. More details will be provided to you as we proceed with this plan over the months ahead. If you have any questions about this plan, please feel free to speak to Pastor Bill or one of our deacons.

Transition Advisory Group (TAG) – This group of staff and volunteers will provide continuity for Parke's current responsibilities; will provide training and advice for the new minister(s) who ultimately assumes his responsibilities; and will recommend, plan, and coordinate retirement celebration activities with review and approval by the Deacons Council. Members of this group have been selected based on their familiarity with and willingness to support our on-going ministry during the transition period. The TAG has been appointed by the deacons based on recommendations from the ministry team. The chairpersons for each area of responsibility identified below will comprise the TAG with support from other named individuals. Your TAG team is already at work.

Minister Search Committee (MSC) – This committee will help the church identify ministry support needs both now and for our future; will help the church identify ministry position(s) needed to best meet current and future needs; will identify and recommend an interim worship leader to the Deacon Council and the church; will collect names of candidates to fill needed ministry position(s); and will interview ministry candidates and make recommendation(s) to the church for action. Members of this committee will be selected in the following manner, which is in accord with our church constitution and by-laws and is modeled after the process used to form the last Pastor Search Committee.

- Each member of the current Deacon Council will provide ten (10) names of church members whom they nominate for membership on the MSC by Friday, January 29, 2021 at noon. Names will be given either to Pastor Bill or Mike Overstreet in a sealed envelope.
- The top five names based on Deacon Council nominations will be published in *The Banner* the week of February 1. Note that Pastor Bill will serve as an ex officio member of the MSC.
- The deacon recommended MSC will be brought before the church in a called church business meeting at noon on Sunday, February 7, 2021. The called business meeting will be live-streamed with text/phone-in comment capability for those viewing/listening to the meeting remotely. During the called business meeting the floor will be open for nominations from the church in addition to the names recommended by the Deacon Council. If there are no nominations from the floor, then the MSC as recommended by



the deacons will be elected by consensus. If there are additional nominations from the floor, then a paper ballot will be mailed to every church member the week of February 8. Ballots must be marked and returned to the church office either by mail or in person no later than Thursday, February 25 at noon. The top five vote-getters will be elected as the MSC and will be announced during the worship service on Sunday, February 28.

• The MSC will develop a methodology to gather input from the church regarding ministry support needs and position(s) needed to meet those needs. They will prayerfully seek the candidate(s) needed to lead us in fulfilling our identified ministry needs and will present them to the church for a vote at a called church meeting per our constitution and by-laws. Note that if multiple ministry positions need to be filled, the MSC will continue to serve until all needed ministry positions are filled.
