Shawn and his wife Liz live in Bluefield. Shawn will commute to rehearse and record with our Sanctuary Choir on Wednesday evenings.

Shawn was highly recommended to us by Barry Green, former Minister of Music & Worship at Bonsack Baptist Church. He was mentored by Rev. Bryant Moxley, who now serves as Minister of

Music at Wake Forest Baptist Church. Shawn has a Bachelor of Arts in Church Music and a Master of Arts in Education from Bluefield College. He and Liz both serve as music educators in the Mercer County WV public school system. Shawn works at Montcalm/Bluewell Elementary School where he teaches music theory, history, and instructs students in instrumental ensembles including handbells, guitar, and voice. Shawn served for just over one year as Interim Music Director for Marion Baptist Church and for almost two years as Interim Music Director at First Baptist Church Bluefield.
