Continued from Pastor Bill...

MSC Listening Session 1 will be held in Fellowship Hall beginning **at 9:30am on Sunday**, **May 23**. This meeting will replace our regular adult Bible study classes that Sunday, but our children and youth will continue to meet. Coffee and donuts will be available. The MSC will briefly summarize input received from the recent MSC survey. The primary focus of the meeting will be for the committee to listen to your additional input regarding our church's ministry needs and the search for appropriate staff to meet those needs. **This session will also be available on ZOOM** for those who wish to participate in that mode. MSC Listening Session 2 will be held in Fellowship Hall beginning at **7:00pm on Wednesday, May 26**. The format and purpose of this session will be the same as in Session 1. This second opportunity is for anyone who could not participate in Session 1 or who has additional input to share. Session 2 will also be **available on ZOOM** for those who wish to participate in that mode. The ZOOM link and dial in phone number, Meeting ID, and Passcode are the same as those for Session 1 above.



Lebanon-to-Lebanon Virtual Mission Trip – This Wednesday morning May 5 we will complete our five week in-depth virtual mission trip to the country of Lebanon. We have learned about the six major ministries of the Lebanese Society for Educational and Social Development (LSESD). As we began this virtual trip, we asked you to give to support LSESD's efforts through their Middle East Revive and Thrive (MERATH) ministry to provide hygiene kits to refugees living in Lebanon. These kits are a vital resource as one-in-three persons living in Lebanon toady are

refugees and COVID-19 is on the rise. We raised and sent \$1,100 from our church which provided 66 hygiene kits.

Camp-in-a-Box – As we conclude our virtual mission trip to Lebanon. I and the twelve other participants from our church encourage you to join us in prayerful and financial support of another important project of LSESD through their Baptist Children and Youth Ministry (BCYM). Normally BCYM hosts camps for children and youth during the summer, but due to COVID-19, in-person camps have not been possible for over a year. We understand this programming dilemma from our own experience here with VBS and other activities last year. However, BCYM leaders came up with a creative solution that they call Camp-in-a-Box. The boxes contain curriculum and supplies for twelve days of Bible study and activities for children and youth. Boxes were prepared and distributed last year not only for summer camp but also for Christmas and earlier this year for Easter. These boxes have been received enthusiastically throughout Lebanon. Reports coming back to BCYM indicate that parents, cousins, and neighbors are joining in the Bible studies and activities. The gospel is going forth in a powerful, innovative way. This success has led BCYM to set a goal of sending out 2,000 Camp-in-a-Box kits this summer. The boxes cost about \$35 each to prepare and distribute. We call for you to join us in supporting this gospel mission effort by making a donation to the Camp-in-a-Box program. Designate Camp-in-a-Box on your check or envelope. There is also a Camp-in-the-Box option in our online giving channel. Pray for LSESD/BCYM workers as they prepare and send these boxes and for those who receive the boxes to respond with faith and joy to the good news of Jesus Christ.
