

# **F**rom Our Pastor. . .



Worship Services Open for Full Participation – When our Deacon Council met last Thursday evening we discussed our guidelines for Sunday morning worship. It was the consensus of the Council, based on declining cases of Covid-19 and the increasing number of those having received the vaccine, that the time has come to open up our worship services for full, in-person participation. As of Sunday, June 13 masks are optional based on individual needs/preferences, all pews will be open for seating, the choir will return live in the choir loft, we will once again sing together, and you may use any exit after the service. We will not pass the offering plates as we did in the past. You may continue to place your offering in the plates as you enter or exit the sanctuary as you have been doing since last year. We pray that there will not be a surge in the virus later this year. As always, I and

the Deacon Council will continue to monitor the health situation in our area and will make adjustments to our schedule and practices as needed. We will also continue to live-stream our worship service via the church website, Vimeo, YouTube, and Facebook. An audio link will continue to be provided via ZOOM for those tuning in by phone.

In addition to opening our Sunday worship services, Bible study is available for all ages on Sunday mornings at 9:45am. Most of the adult classes will continue to live-stream via the ZOOM links on our church website. In addition to opening worship for full, in-person participation, we are also planning an in-person VBS July 19-23 and the resumption of our Wednesday night programming with an evening meal, children's music/missions, and adult Bible study when school starts in August. It has been a year and three months since we have been able to gather for unrestricted worship and Bible study on Sunday mornings. It is good to gather again in the house of the Lord. Come and join us!

Join the Choir - What a blessing it was to have the choir leading us in worship through singing together on Sunday. I am glad that they once again have my back! We want to add to their number as we return to somewhat normal worship services. We appreciate those volunteers who have been a part of the recorded choir over the past year. They are ready for you to join them live in the choir loft on Sunday mornings. If you



have an interest in joining the choir, please come out on a Wednesday evening at 7pm in the near future. The choir meets in the sanctuary at that time, and they would love to meet you. Singing to the glory of God is an important part of worship. Please consider joining the choir in order to add your voice to the harmony of praise as they lead us in worship.

This year we will follow an evening format beginning with a kid-friendly meal at 5:30pm in Fellowship Hall. VBS will start at 6:00pm with an opening time in the Chapel. 
## **PENCIL PROJECT**

We know school was just dismissed for the summer; however, school will re-start in Washington County on August 10<sup>th</sup>. As far as we know, school will be in-person. As in the past, the Friends of Audrey & Jill WMU Circle is working with other churches to provide school supply bags to Stone Soup Food Pantry (SSFP) to be given out to customers with children as they pick up their food. Following is a listing of items that we include in the bags:

- 2 paks of 70 wide ruled paper (or equivalent)
- 2 spiral bound paper
- 1 composition book
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 2 erasers
- 1 pencil box
- 2 paks of 10 #2 pencils (or equivalent)
- 1 pak of 10 pens (either black or blue ink)
- 1 pak colored pencils (usually come in paks of 10 or 12)
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair Fiskars scissors

We would appreciate your help by either providing some of the items listed or providing a cash (check) donation and we will do the shopping. We will then assemble the bags and get them delivered to SSFP so ours with other churches will be enough to hand out before the first week of school. We will need to have bags to SSFP by 7/23 so they can be handed out the last week of July and the first week of August.
