

Kentucky Disaster Relief

Thank you for your generous giving in support of flood relief efforts in Kentucky. In the span of a week you have given \$10,645 to help with recovery from this disaster. Glory to God!



Last Friday, Willie Morris, Mike Overstreet, Roger Garrett, and I travelled to the Jackson, KY area to deliver about \$4,000 of relief supplies to the Kentucky River Community Care, Inc. (KYCC) warehouse. Vicey Pelfrey, Willie's second cousin, is Division Director of KYCC and was on-site coordinating distribution of supplies to those in need. She is pictured with Willie in the left side picture. We took five generators along with several 2-gallon gas cans, \$1,000 in gas cards, and other needed supplies. Vicey had us load the generators directly into her pickup and left soon after us to deliver them to several elderly persons who needed oxygen concentrators but were without power to run them. These supplies truly were life-saving.

We will continue to assess needs and plan to return later this week with more supplies. Our BGAV Disaster Response team has been called up to help at sites in Kentucky and Buckhannon Co. VA to assist with mud-outs and other clean up needs. Keep praying and giving as the Lord leads you. Pray about the possibility of going with a team in September to help with recovery and rebuild. Let Pastor Bill know if you are interested in going to deliver supplies or to help with recovery. God is present in the midst of this tragedy for good, and you are His hands reaching out with love and His feet going to serve.


