This Week (12/1-8) Is the Week of Prayer for International Missions – We will receive our Lottie Moon Christmas Offering for international missions until the end of January 2025. <u>Our church goal this year is \$5,000</u>. You may give to this offering by designating either the "Lottie Moon – SBC" or the "Lottie Moon – CBF" channel of giving. Monies given will be forwarded 100% to the designated organization for support of

Lottie Moon Post Office Is Open – Instead of mailing your Christmas cards to other church members, please bring them to church and drop them off at the Lottie Moon Post Office (LMPO) located in Fellowship Hall. Our Lottie Moon elves will sort them and hand them out to our members. You can then donate the cost of the postage saved, not an insignificant amount these days, to our annual Lottie Moon Offering for International Missions. The LMPO will be open until Sunday, December 22.

2025 Budget Challenge – Our 2025 budget was unanimously approved by the church during the called business meeting last Sunday. Our 2025 budget presents a challenge of \$71,470 above our projected total year end giving for 2024. With God's help and working together, we can meet this challenge. We have 285 resident members representing 106 resident families. The proposed 2025 budget can be met or exceeded if each of our families will increase their giving by \$60/mo. (106 families x \$60/mo x 12 mo = \$76,320).

We are ministering to many needs and in many significant ways in our church, community, and world. It takes each of us giving a tithe (typically 10% of gross earnings) as well as offerings above our tithes in order to see the Lord's work done in our part of His kingdom. Be faithful in attending, praying, and giving your time, talents, and treasure as we serve the Lord together. We can do it with His help as we follow Him together.


