202nd BGAV Annual Meeting: November 10-12, 2025 at Highlands Fellowship, Abingdon, VA

**Deacon Election 2025** – It is once again time for our church to elect deacons. The deacon nomination and election process is underway.

Nomination Procedure – Nominations will be received until Sunday, September 14 at noon. You may nominate someone by completing a Deacon Nomination Form, which is available in the church office and at the sanctuary entryways. Your completed Nomination Form must be returned to Pastor Bill in person or dropped-off at the church office no later than noon on Sunday, September 14. The pastor will add each qualified nominee to the slate of candidates. Please note that there are six deacons rotating off this year, and they are not eligible for re-election until next year. They are Kevin Abel, Jerry Culberson, Saundra Farmer, John Looney, Ray Minor and Rose Payne.

<u>Election Procedure</u> – The slate of deacon nominees will be published in *The Banner* the week of September 15. **We will hold an election at a called church business meeting on Sunday, September 28** immediately following our morning worship service. Deacons, including the newly elected ones, will meet after the business meeting to elect officers for the coming year. Results of the deacon election will be announced in *The Banner* the following week. Those elected will begin serving on October 1, 2025.
