WORSHIP

Called Church Business Meeting this Sunday, June 14

There will be a called church business meeting after worship this Sunday, June 14 for those church members present to vote on the following matter.

The Council of Deacons recommends that the church vote to replace the old pew cushions on the 66 pews in our sanctuary, balcony, and chapel with new cushions to be provided by Church Outlet in Highpoint, NC at a total cost of \$22,500. The new cushions will be red, matching the decor of our existing carpet and pews, will have no buttons but will include a non-skid pad underlayment.

The cost of \$22,500 will be covered by offerings from church members matched dollar-for-dollar from designated funds up to \$11,250. In other words, \$11,250 in church member offerings plus \$11,250 in designated funds already on hand equals the \$22,500 cost. The cost per pew is \$341 (\$22,500 / 66 pews).

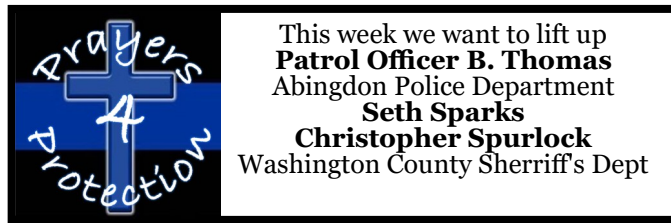

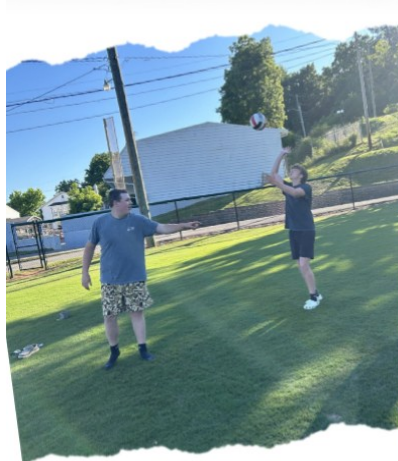
